

Teacher: Bishop Ben Duncan Time: Sunday Morning, April 14, 2024 Title: "The Amazing Results from Godly Giving" Text: 2 Corinthians 9:6-15 (Printed and Presented)

6 But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work. 9 As it is written: "He has dispersed abroad, He has given to the poor; His righteousness endures forever." 10 Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, 11 while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. 12 For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God, 13 while, through the proof of this ministry, they glorify God for the obedience of your confession to the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal sharing with them and all men, 14 and by their prayer for you, who long for you because of the exceeding grace of God in you. 15 Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift! Tale: What is this passage talking about?

Corinth was an international hub with great wealth. In such an environment, many callous and selfish attitudes prevailed. Even in the church, charitable kindness was woefully absent. So, Paul encourages believers to be countercultural and give generously to their church and community. Paul explains to the Corinthians (and us) about the astonishing effects released via godly giving.

Truth: What do these scriptures mean to us?

Sadly, uncaring attitudes and self-centeredness still prevail. Barna reports (2022)¹ within the modern local church (USA) among self-identifying Christians, only 21% give 10 percent or more of their income, 54% give less than 10%, and 25% do not give to their church at all. Yet, when the truth about the blessings of generosity is finally discovered and then faithfully practiced by the believers, it blesses both the givers and the recipients in so many ways.

- That 1: God's Law of Reciprocity is Explained for Us (6)
- That 2: God's Love of Generosity is Expressed about Us (7)
- Thot 3: God's Lavishing of Prosperity is Exported upon Us (8-10)

Thot 4: God's Liberality causes a Thanksgiving that is Exemplified through Us (11-15) A. Our Unselfish Giving Sustains/Substantiates our Ministries, Sending God Exaltation (11-14) B. God's Unspeakable Gift of His Son, our Savior, the Messiah, Serves as Our Example (15)

Transformation: How should this truth change me?

I will be a blessing to others through giving and sharing of what God has entrusted to me to manage. Hereafter, I will tithe 10% of my income, and give offerings above my tithe, to my local church. Your weakness: God's STRENGTH! The Book of Judges: Chapters 6, 7, and 8

April 17, 2024 6th and Final Session "Who is Your King?" Presenter: Priscilla Shirer; Facilitator: Ben Duncan

- 1. Priscilla says that we often think of ourselves as *human beings having a spiritual experience*; but she says that we should rather think of ourselves as *spiritual beings having a human experience*. Discuss.
- Read Judg. 8:22; 21:25; Deu. 17:14-15; Jos. 24:15; Mat. 6:24; Rom.
 6:16-18. Now, answer, "Who or what has <u>authority</u> in my life?"
- 3. Read Deu. 6:10-12; Judg. 8:23; Psa. 75:6; Isa. 14:12-15; 1 Cor. 2:1-5. To whom have you been giving the <u>credit</u>? Do you often take the credit? What is the danger in doing so?
- 4. Read Deu. 20:13-14; Judg. 8:24-25; 1 Chr. 26:27; Isa. 42:8; Jer. 9:23-24; Acts 12:21-23; 1 Tim. 1:17; 1 Cor. 1:31.
 Do you <u>deflect</u> glory back to God? If so, then how do you do it? If not, then why not? What is the danger in not doing so?
- 5. Read Judg. 8:27; Mal. 3: 8-12; Eph. 6:10-11; 2 Cor. 6:14-18; Jas. 1:12-15. *It became a <u>snare</u> to Gideon and his household.* Are we keeping anything that <u>belongs</u> to God? Do you notice any possible *snares* in your life right now? What are some ways in which some people take what is rightfully God's? What is the remedy?
- 6. Read Gen. 1:26-28; 6:5-9; 12:1-3; Deu. 28:1-14; Jn. 3:16. What is the Suzerain/Vassal covenant? Which is the greater and protects and provides for the lesser? Which one is the lesser and is submissive, obedient, in service, and pays tribute to the other? How is it seen in God's covenants with Adam, Noah, Abraham, Israel, and mankind? Can you think of more examples found throughout the Bible?
- 7. Read Deu. 6:4-9; Jos. 24:14-15; Judg. 8:32-35; Psa. 78:1-8; 128:3-4; Prov. 22:6; Eph. 6:4; Col. 3:21. After their miraculous victory, how does the story of Gideon and the nation of Israel conclude? What do you understand caused this result? How can we avoid a similar outcome? What responsibilities do we parents have?
