

Teacher: Bishop Ben Duncan; Time: Sunday Morning, April 7, 2024

Theme: The Seven Signs (John 20:30-31); Title: "A Breakfast by the Sea" (Bonus)

Text: John 21:3-6, 11, 14, 17 (Printed); John 21:1-25 (Presented)

3 Simon Peter said to them, "I am going fishing." They said to him, "We are going with you also." They went out and immediately got into the boat, and that night they caught nothing. 4 But when the morning had now come, Jesus stood on the shore; yet the disciples did not know that it was Jesus. 5 Then Jesus said to them, "Children, have you any food?" They answered Him, "No." 6 And He said to them, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish. ... 11 Simon Peter went up and dragged the net to land, full of large fish, one hundred and fifty-three; and although there were so many, the net was not broken. ... 14 This is now the third time Jesus showed Himself to His disciples after He was raised from the dead. ... 17 He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of Jonah, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, "Do you love Me?" And he said to Him, "Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep.

Tale: What is this passage talking about?

Peter and six more disciples go fishing. They fish all night but catch nothing. Jesus, unnoticed by them initially, tells them to put their net on the right side and they catch a lot. They go from "no luck" to "no lack!" This is the third time Christ appears to His disciples who, because of their fears and failures, have not yet started their ministry. Jesus then addresses Peter alone.

Truth: What do these scriptures mean to us?

Like the disciples, we too are often negligent in sharing the gospel. Perhaps, like them we become disappointed from our failures, dismayed by our fears, distracted from our focus, and disrupted by the familiar. At times, our Savior, maybe without our even noticing Him, gently nudges us personally vis His Spirit to return to Him and to resume our assigned work!

"How to Win a Battle"

- 1. What did Gideon overhear the enemy say (Jud. 9-15)? How did this instill confidence in him and put fear in his foes? How does reading and believing the Word of God do the same for us (Isa. 55:11; Rom. 10:17)?
- 2. How to win a battle:
 - A. Begin the Battle on Your Knees.

 What did Gideon do (Jud. 7:15a)? Consider these biblical heroes who did similarly: Joshua and Israel (Jos. 6:20); Jehoshaphat (2 Chr. 20:9, 12, 15, 17-22); Job (Job 1:20-22); Daniel (Dan. 6:10); Paul and Silas (Acts 16:25-26); Jesus (Mat. 26:36-46). Do you begin your battles with prayer and praise? Why is this necessary (Phil 4:4-9)?
 - B. Face the Battle from a <u>Stance</u> of <u>Victory</u>. How does Gideon's countenance change (Jud. 7:15a)? How does following his example enable us to arise from our insecurities, fears, and anxiety? What is the change in perspective like when we determine to <u>fight from victory</u> instead of to fight for victory? How did he accept God's strategy (Jud. 7:16-18)? Why is it vital for us to do so (Pro. 3:5-7; Isa. 55:8-9; Jer. 29:11; Act 15:18; Rom. 8:28, 37)?
 - C. Advance into the Battle from Your <u>Assigned Place</u>. How do Gideon and the 300 do this (Jud. 7:19a, 21)? What does Eph. 2:10 say about God's involvement in using us for His good works? <u>Your part matters!</u> What is your part, your place, your position, your calling, your gift(s)? Where has God put you now (Est.4:14; 1 Cor. 12:4-12, 18; Eph. 4:11-16)?
 - D. Approach the Battle at just the <u>Right Time</u>.

 When did Gideon and the 300 approach the enemy (Jud. 7:19b)?

 <u>Timing matters</u> (Est. 5:1-3, 8; Eccl. 3:1-11; Act 17:24-26; Gal. 4:4-5)!
 - E. You Win the Battle by Using the Right Weapons (Jud. 7:20-22).
 Our weaponry is unusual; it is spiritual (Isa. 54:17; 2 Cor. 10:3-4; Eph. 6:10-18; Heb. 4:12-13)! The battle is divided into two parts (the human; and the divine). This is how we cooperate with God so He does His work through us (Exo. 14:26-27; 1 Sam. 17:40, 45, 49)!
